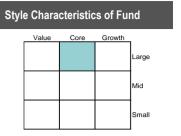

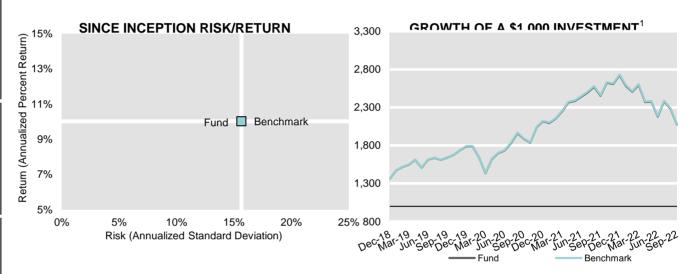
# WHAT IS IT1:

This investment option focuses on stocks that make up the S&P 500. The fund is managed by Northern Trust. This is not a mutual fund.

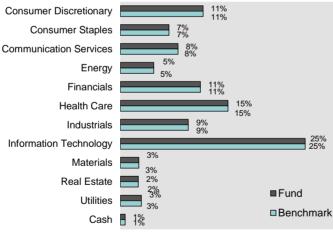

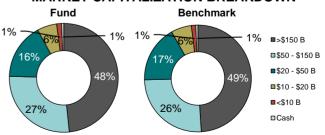

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### **Definitions**

**Standard deviation** is a measure of risk that gauges the variability of actual returns from their expected values and the dispersion of these variations over time.

**Excess return** represents the fund total return minus the return of the index.

**Tracking error** represents the volatility of fund return relative to the benchmark, calculated as the standard deviation of the return relative to the benchmark.

**Information ratio** is a risk adjusted measure of performance calculated as excess return divided by tracking error.

Beta measures the fund's sensitivity to market movements in the broad based index.

**R-squared** is a measure that indicates the extent to which fluctuations in fund returns are correlated with those of the broad based index.

**Sharpe Ratio** is a measure that indicates the average return earned in excess of the risk free rate per unit of volatility or risk. **Average Annual Turnover** measures the value of portfolio holdings that have been traded as a percentage of portfolio holdings during the fund's last fiscal year.
