T. Rowe Price Institutional High Yield Fund

Objective: The Fund seeks high current income and, secondarily, capital appreciation.

Strategy: The fund normally invests at least 80% of its net assets (including any borrowings for investment purposes) in a widely diversified portfolio of high yield corporate bonds, often called "junk" bonds, as well as income-producing convertible securities and preferred stocks that are rated below investment grade or not rated by any major credit rating agency but deemed to be below investment grade by T. Rowe Price.

BNYM Mellon NSL Aggregate Bond Institutional

Objective: The Fund's investment objective is to seek to track the performance of the Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Bond Index. ("Index").

Strategy: In meeting this objective, the Fund may invest in securities (including those issued through private placements) and a combination of other collective funds that together are designed to track the performance of the Index. The Fund will principally invest in other affiliated bank collective funds, debt securities of U.S. corporations and the U.S. government, its agencies and instrumentalities, including mortgage-related and asset-based securities.

Balanced¹⁰

Vanguard Balanced Index Fund – Institutional Shares

Objective: The investment seeks to track the performance of a benchmark index that measures the investment return of the overall U.S. stock market with 60% of its assets. The fund seeks to track the performance of a broad, market-weighted bond index with 40% of its assets.

Strategy: The fund employs an indexing investment approach designed to track the performance of two benchmark indexes. With approximately 60% of its assets, the fund seeks to track the investment performance of the CRSP US Total Market Index. With approximately 40% of its assets, the fund seeks to track the investment performance of the Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Float Adjusted Index.

Large-Cap

American Century Disciplined Core Value I

Objective: The Fund seeks long-term capital growth by investing in common stocks. Income is a secondary objective.

Strategy: In selecting stocks for the fund, the managers use quantitative management techniques in a two-step process. First, the managers rank stocks, primarily large capitalization, publicly traded U.S. companies with a market capitalization greater than \$2 billion, from most attractive to least attractive based on an objective set of measures. Second, the portfolio managers use a quantitative model to build a portfolio of stocks from the ranking that they believe will provide the optimal balance between risk and expected return.

iShares S&P 500 Index K Fund⁴

Objective: BlackRock S&P 500 Stock Fund (the "Fund"), a series of BlackRock Funds III (the "Trust"), seeks to provide investment results that correspond to the total return performance of publicly traded common stocks in the aggregate, as represented by the Standard & Poor's 500[®] Index ("S&P 500 Index").

Strategy: The Fund pursues it investment objective by seeking to replicate the total return performance of the S&P 500 Index, which is composed of 500 selected common stocks, most of which are listed on the New York Stock Exchange (the "NYSE"). The S&P 500 Index is a capitalization-weighted index from a broad range of industries chosen for market size, liquidity and industry group representation. The component stocks are weighted according to the total float-adjusted market value of their outstanding share (i.e., they are weighted according to the public float which is the total market value of their outstanding shares readily available to the general marketplace for trading purposes). The percentage of the Fund's assets invested in a given stock is approximately the same as the percentage such stock represents in the S&P 500 Index. Under normal circumstances, at least 90% of the value of the Fund's assets, plus the amount of any borrowing for investment purposes, is invested in securities comprising the S&P 500 Index.

T. Rowe Price Blue Chip Growth Fund

Objective: The Fund seeks to provide long-term capital growth. Income is a secondary objective.

Strategy: The fund will normally invest at least 80% of its net assets (including any borrowings for investment purposes) in the common stocks of large and medium-sized blue chip growth companies. It focuses on companies with leading market positions, seasoned management, and strong financial fundamentals. The fund is non-diversified.

T. Rowe Price Total Equity Market Index Fund⁴

Objective: The Fund seeks to match the performance of the entire U.S. stock market. The fund uses the S&P Total Market Index as its benchmark index to represent the U.S. stock market as a whole. Because the largest stocks in the index carry the most weight, large-capitalization stocks make up a substantial majority of the S&P Total Market's value.

Mid-Cap⁵

Vanguard Selected Value Investor Fund

Objective: The Fund seeks maximum long-term capital appreciation and income.

Strategy: The fund invests mainly in the stocks of mid-size U.S. companies, choosing stocks considered by an advisor to be undervalued. Undervalued stocks are generally those that are out of favor with investors and are trading at prices that the advisor believes are below average in relation to measures such as earnings and book value. These stocks often have above-average dividend yields. It uses multiple investment advisors.

BAIRD MID CAP GROWTH SMA

Objective: The investment seeks long-term growth of capital.

Strategy: The fund normally invests at least 80% of its net assets, plus any borrowings for investment purposes, in the equity securities of U.S. and foreign mid-capitalization companies, principally common stocks, preferred stocks, securities convertible into common stocks and American Depositary Receipts ("ADRs") that are traded on major U.S. exchanges. Although the fund principally invests in U.S. companies, the fund may invest up to 15% of its total assets in equity securities (consisting of common stocks, ordinary shares and ADRs) of foreign companies.

Small-Cap⁵

BlackRock Advantage Small Cap Growth Fund - Institutional

Objective: The investment seeks long-term capital growth.

Strategy: The Fund will invest at least 80% of its net assets (plus any borrowings for investment purposes) in equity securities of small cap companies and at least 80% of its net assets (plus any borrowings for investment purposes) in securities or instruments of issuers located in the United States. The advisor defines these companies as those with market capitalizations, at the time of the fund's investment, comparable in size to the companies in the Russell 2000^(R) Index. From time to time it may invest in shares of companies through "new issues" or initial public offerings ("IPOs").

BNYM Mellon NSL Small Cap Stock Institutional

Objective: The Fund seeks to track the performance of the Russell 2000^(R) Index ("Index").

Strategy: In meeting this objective, the assets of the Fund may be invested in securities and a combination of other affiliated bank collective funds that together are designed to track the performance of such Index. The Fund will principally invest in other affiliated bank collective funds and equity securities, including common stock of U.S. companies.

Janus Henderson Small Cap Value Fund N

Objective: The Fund seeks capital appreciation.

Strategy: The fund pursues its investment objective by investing primarily in the common stocks of small companies whose stock prices are believed to be undervalued by the fund's portfolio managers. It invests, under normal circumstances, at least 80% of its net assets (plus any borrowings for investment purposes) in equity securities of small companies whose market capitalization, at the time of initial purchase, is less than the 12-month average of the maximum market capitalization for companies included in the Russell 2000^(R) Value Index. The fund may invest up to 20% of its net assets in cash or similar investments.

American Funds EuroPacific Growth Fund A

Objective: The Fund's investment objective is to provide long-term growth of capital.

Strategy: Normally, the Fund will invest at least 80% of its net assets in securities of issuers located in Europe and the Pacific Basin. Various factors will be considered when determining whether a country is part of Europe, including whether a country is part of the MSCI European indices. A country will be considered part of the Pacific Basin if any of its borders touches the Pacific Ocean.

BNYM Mellon NSL ACWI ex-U.S. Fund Institutional

Objective: The objective of the BNY Mellon ACWI ex-U.S. strategy is to track the MSCI ACWI ex-U.S Index.

Strategy: The Fund attempts to replicate a majority of the total capitalization of the index and sampling from the remaining securities that are subject to higher trading costs, liquidity constraints, and market constraints. The portfolio manager continuously evaluates the portfolio's composition relative to the index being tracked, and if a factor bias threshold is exceeded, the portfolio is rebalanced.

T. Rowe Price Emerging Markets Stock Fund

Objective: The Fund seeks long-term growth of capital through investments primarily in the common stocks of companies located (or with primary operations) in emerging markets.

Strategy: The fund will normally invest at least 80% of its net assets (including any borrowings for investment purposes) in emerging market companies. The fund may purchase the stocks of companies of any size. The fund expects to make substantially all of its investments in common stocks of companies located (or with primary operations) in emerging markets in Latin America, Asia, Europe, Africa, and the Middle East.
